REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPLETING THESIS

1. In the upper right corner (without abbreviations) - author's first and last name, scientific degree, academic rank, position, institution, educational institution, city, country (Times New Roman font, 14 point, spacing - 1, Italics).

2. Below, one space apart, is the topic in the middle of the line (Times New Roman font, 14, bold, uppercase).

3. After one interval, the text of the thesis, which must meet the following requirements: A4 format, margins - top, bottom, left, right - 2 cm, font Times New Roman, point 14, line spacing 1.5 (a sample of the design of thesis is provided below).

The list of resources is at the end of the text under the title "Resources" taking into account the National Standard of Ukraine DSTU 8302:2015.

In the text, footnotes are marked with square brackets indicating the serial number of the source in the list and the page (pages) numbers after a comma, for example: [7, p.16]. Text length: 3–5 pages with a list of sources used.

Works that do not meet the requirements or are not submitted by the deadline will not be considered.
